## APPLICATION FOR NISLT MANDATORY PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION (MPF) DECEMBER 2023 DIET-MODULE II (FOR INTERNAL & EXTERNAL CANDIDATES)

The NISLT is a global professional Scientists/Technologists Institute with more than 25,000 registered members. The Institute is charged with the general duty of- advancing Science Laboratory Technology profession; determining the standards of knowledge, exposure to equipment, practical and skills, to be attained by persons seeking to become registered members of the profession and reviewing those standards, from time to time, as circumstances may require; promoting the highest standards of competence, practice and conduct among the members of the profession; serving as a certifying agency through its registered members; ensuring safety standards and necessary facilities in science laboratories and workshops in Nigeria; ensuring, through its registered members, effective and efficient management and administration of all science laboratories in Nigeria; conducting inspection of science laboratories in schools, post-secondary Institutions, *Industries* and research Institutes in order to improve the professional standards, among others;

The Council of the Institute reviewed, modified and approved the new curriculum for the Professional Examinations-

To earn the AISLT registration, individuals must study and demonstrate a mastery of Practical in their areas of specialization (PAPER 1), theory in areas of the core techniques (PAPER II); General Laboratory Procedures, Instrument Maintenance, Laboratory Services Units (PAPER III); and Laboratory Organization and Management. Application of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in the Laboratory (PAPER IV).

The examinations will be based on the NISLT Council approved professional examination syllabus which can be downloaded from the Institute's website www.nislt.gov.ng

**Date of the next examination-** The Module I & II professional examination is scheduled to hold in October and December 2023.

**Eligibility For Enrolment**- The examinations are open to holders of Final Diploma/HND/B,Tech/B.Sc. in SLT (ONLY).

**Examination Registration-** The registration portal for the December 2023 diet examinations will close on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023.

Mode of Registration- External Candidates will register directly on the MPE portal of NISLT website, while internal students will contact their institutions' HOD for online registration code. Before visiting the institute website <a href="www.nislt.gov.ng">www.nislt.gov.ng</a>.
